1. Please submit the abstract (about 300 words) of your paper via email **no later than September 15, 2015.**

2. The official invitation letter will be delivered by the organizer no later than September 25, 2015.

3. Please submit the paper (within 10,000 words) **no later than October 15, 2015** on receiving the official invitation letter of the conference. The admitted papers will be edited into a book and be published officially after the conference.

4. Paper format: (1) abstract in Chinese and English, key words(3-5words), author’s name, author’s office, author’s position, correspondence address, telephone number, email address, reference citations are supposed to be included. (2) Note at the bottom of the page. Notes and information should be complete and concrete.

**VIII. Fee:** RMB 800 shall be paid as conference fee (including materials and meeting rooms rent etc.) while round-trip travel expenses and accommodation cost will be on your own account.
